



Dear Residents,

Roadstone Ltd is working on behalf of the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the National Transport Authority, proposing Active Travel Improvements on Glenageary Road Upper between the Sallynoggin and Killiney Towers Roundabouts.

1. Details of works completed up to Monday 17th June 2024 and remaining works until the 30th August 2024

Work Completed to date:

All road milling and resurfacing works have been completed to road binder level. The final layer of material will be placed in the following weeks.

Traffic management will be back to a two-way system from Sallynoggin Roundabout towards Killiney Towers Roundabout from Tuesday the 18th June. There will be a Stop & Go traffic management for various sections of remaining civil works and road resurfacing until the 30th August 2024.

The remaining works include:

- Civil and Road Resurfacing works at Sallynoggin Roundabout.
- Isolated footpath repairs between Sallynoggin Roundabout and Killiney Towers Roundabout
- Mainline Resurfacing between Sallynoggin Roundabout and Killiney Towers Roundabout
- High friction surfacing between Sallynoggin Roundabout and Killiney Towers Roundabout
- Ironworks and Road lining between Sallynoggin Roundabout and Killiney Towers Roundabout
